Hailing from Philadelphia the city of brotherly love and sisterly affection, Barbara Walker's name exemplifies the word "excitement". Her career is rich and varied, marked by performances and recordings with the finest artist and musicians, Pieces Of a Dream, Grover Washington, Patti Labelle, Lionel Hampton, Natalie Cole and the list continues.

Barbara has the unique ability to vocally blend her experience in R & B, Jazz, Pop and inspiration into a powerful vocal style that cannot be put into a box.

As a young girl in the early 80's Barbara recorded the lead vocals for the R & B hit "Warm Weather" with Jazz/R&B group Pieces of A Dream.

Barbara went onto record several other songs with the group. She later caught the attention of the producers for the long running PBS educational TV Show "Sesame Street". Barbara recorded a song for the show that teaches its youth viewer ship the consonants "B", "D" and "M".

She continues touring, teaming up with hot Jazz pianist Uri kane and in 2001-2002 the two of them embarked on a European tour performing from Italy to Jerusalem. In addition in 2001 Barbara's voice shared the screen with the legendary Robert DeNiro on the song "Here Comes The Morning" featured in the blockbuster film "The Score" starring Mr. DeNiro and the great Marlon Brando.

In between touring Barbara found time to go into Philadelphia International recording studio's with Helen Bruner and Terry Jones to record the vocal for her single "Saved Me" on SoulShine Recordings co-penned by Bruner, Jones and Louis Benedetti.

The result is uplifting and inspirational, produced by Mr. Benedetti "Saved Me" was recently nominated at the prestigious HMA (House Music Awards) as an Outstanding Vocal release from 2004.

Be on the lookout for Ms. Barbara Walker because bringing down the house is her specialty!
