She then began to establish her reputation and gain local support and her fan base. While under an exclusive recording contract with Crystal Entertainment, her writing and singing skills were now apart of an established recording company.

During this time she developed performance material, co-wrote several songs for other producers, and recorded with slue of vocalists and rappers. Recording deals were offered from Jive Records, East West Records, and the local Luke Records. During this genuine time of learning and growing, she also auditioned for an event production company Gatlum Entertainment and was offered the part of lead singer for their house band. It was during this time that she explored singing in a live jazz band and performing live shows. It is this opportunity that helped develop her stage presentation, image, and crowd control.

Following the springboard, she was the major singer and MC for the local jazz spot Backstage where she appeared in the movie "Eden" one of Miami Beach feature films, and began working behind the scenes to develop her untitled album.

It was then a collaboration with Louis Benedetti on the renowned "Cloud 9" tune, that combined her skills to bring her best and deliver one of underground House Music's all time favorite!

Currently, she provides singing and writing classes for up-coming artists, co-write for local released talents, as well as provide background vocals, arrangements and harmonies to accent various music projects.
